Loving nephew, cousin, uncle, great uncle, and friend to many.

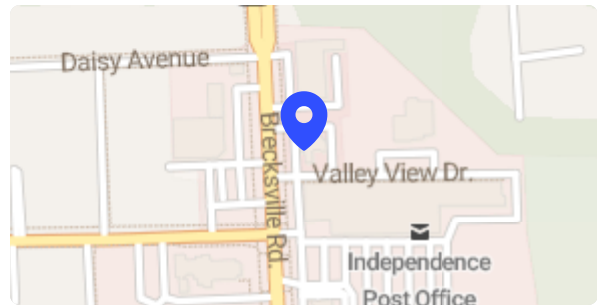

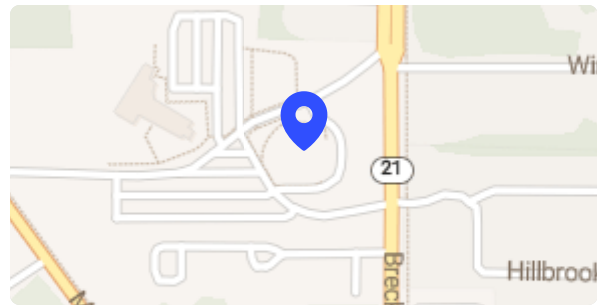

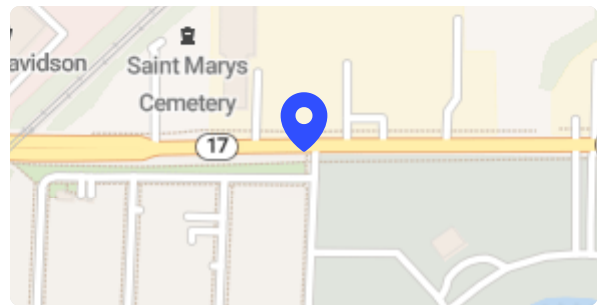
